LESS SWELLING – the laser energy does not crush, tear or bruise the tissue because there is no physical contact with the tissue.

Your pet will be treated with a carbon dioxide laser, which producers an invisible beam of light that can render a precise layer of tissue at one time. This can reduce your pet's post-operative recovery time, leading to a quicker return to normal activities.
